Compro can retrieve your old SEL, Gould or Encore data and re-write it using modern, reliable media products. If desired, Compro also can perform 9-track to 9-track transfers using new, fresh tapes.

Description

For a fixed price, Compro accepts any one of the following media:

- One disk pack
- · One disk drive
- Three magnetic tapes (9-track, QIC, etc.)
- One 4 mm DAT

and provides the following services:

- · Physically inspects the media to determine basic readability.
- Sets up a system with the appropriate peripheral device(s).
- De-compresses (if applicable) and reads data from the supplied media.
- · Generates output media in one of the following formats:
 - Hard copy
 - 9-track, 800 BPI magnetic tape
 - 9-track, 1600 BPI magnetic tape
 - 5 1/4" floppy disk
 - 8" floppy disk
 - 1/4" cartridge tape (requires MPX 3.6.0 or later)
 - 8 mm cartridge tape (Exabyte)
 - 3 1/2" floppy disk
 - 9-track, 6250 BPI tape
 - CD ROM
 - 4 mm DAT
 - DVD ROM



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Media Requirements

This data transfer service is limited to media produced by SEL, Gould or Encore computer systems. Compro cannot accept physically "crashed" disks or heavily-damaged media. The data format is retained with all transfers. Source file data translation is available for an additional fee.

Note: You will need to complete a release document certifying legal ownership of the submitted material and data/ information contained therein. If, after initial inspection and equipment setup, the media is unreadable, it will be returned to you and a flat \$750 inspection/setup/processing fee will be charged.
