Best arguments for Christianity are arguments for the resurrection of Jesus from the dead

- 1. "Minimal facts" argument
- 2. Evidence for the empty tomb
- 3. Evidence for the appearances of Jesus after his death
- 4. Naturalistic theories to explain the appearances all fail

How do we know gesus rose from the dead?

- 1. Evidence from history
- 2. Experience of Jesus

Evidence from history (2 steps)

- 1. 4 things need to be explained (Jesus' burial, Jesus' empty tomb, Jesus' appearances after death, the disciples belief in the resurrection)
- 2. Jesus' resurrection is the best explanation

Step #1: 4 things must be explained (critics agree on these facts!!

- 1. Fact #1: Jesus was buried in the tomb by Joseph of Arimathea
 - a. Jesus' burial is multiply attested in early, independent sources (Mark, source behind Mathew, source between Luke, John, Acts, 1 Cor. 15)
 - b. Joseph of Arimathea is unlikely a Christian invention: if made-up then a follower of Jesus makes more sense
- 2. Fact #2: Jesus' tomb found empty on Sunday morning
 - a. Burial story supports the empty tomb: if Jesus hadn't risen, they could have easily located the shown the body
 - b. Empty tomb story multiply attested (Mark, source behind Matthew/Luke, John, Acts, 1 Cor. 15)
 - c. Discovered empty by witnesses with least credibility: women
 - d. Story lacks signs of being just made-up: it's simple (no prophecy, no OT Scriptures, not described, no reflection, no titles, simple telling in Mark's Gospel)
 - e. The earliest Jewish debate concerns the empty tomb: disciples thought to have stolen the body
- 3. Fact #3: Jesus was seen by individuals and groups after his death
 - a. Paul passes on the resurrection tradition only a matter of years after Jesus' death!
 - b. Early, independent sources for the appearances of Jesus
- 4. Fact #4: disciples suddenly believed in Jesus' resurrection despite having every reason not to
 - a. Their leader was dead (Jewish Messiah had earthly rule, not dead and resurrected)
 - b. Jewish beliefs in resurrection were contrary: resurrection only happened at end of time for all people

Evidence Step #2: Jesus' resurrection is the best explanation (explanatory scope/power, plausibility, no better rival theory)

- 1. Evidence so good that alternate theories are desperate (e.g. identical twin brother)
- 2. A Jewish scholar concedes Jesus was raised from the dead
